Environmental education

- **Employees:** awareness of the choice of suppliers, the composition of products, energy savings.
- **Children:** educational workshop around the farm and the vegetable garden.
- Adults: we remind you of a few rules to follow in individual and collective sanitary facilities:
- Remember to turn off the light
- Have a reasoned use of water (shower/tap)
- Remember to close doors and windows when using the heating
- Do not throw in the toilet: wipes, sanitary napkins, tampons, etc. These, even biodegradable, clog the pipes.

Noise pollution

In a naturist environment, the absence of noise is obvious. Here are some examples:

Pay attention to the volume of your radio or television, to the slamming of doors, to only operate your air conditioners during siesta (from 2 pm. to 4 pm) or at night, to encourage your children in the morning to go to the amusement park so as not to wake everyone up, be discreet when using your cell phone and turn it off during shows. In general, to consider the estate as a space of calm and rest. In this context, the leisure park is at your disposal for activities and games. For our part, we are committed to finishing our night entertainment at 11 pm. except during special festivities (eg: 21/06, 14/07, 21/07 and 15/08)

Respect for others, quality of life

- Smokers: you are in a forest environment extremely vulnerable to fire, be sure to throw your cigarette butts in the ashtrays and not on the ground.
- Papers: the smaller they are, the more numerous they are. Please dispose of chewing gum, candy or other packaging in the trash.
- Garbage rooms: waste is sorted and several containers are available for this purpose (glass, paper, packaging, etc.), next to entrance B1 and in the B2 car park. So as not to disturb other guests, glass objects must be thrown away after 9.30 a.m. and before 8 p.m. Please place them carefully and do not throw them overboard in containers that are not already filled. These premises are cleaned daily, we thank you for respecting the work of our team for your well-being and theirs. Respecting this place is also a reflection of the behavior of a good citizen.

A composter is at your disposal on the farm next to the vegetable garden, do not throw away the plastic bags containing your peelings. We remind you that the small bins installed on the estate and in the toilets are exclusively intended for small waste, under no circumstances should you deposit your household waste there.





Fire prevention

- Be careful with candles inside and outside the tents and with camping-gas, cigarette butt... Don't let children play with fire...
- Apart from the collective barbecue, only gas and electric barbecues are allowed. In periods of severe drought associated with wind, we could close the collective barbecue as a precaution.

Instruction in case of fire

- In case of fire, do not panic and immediately inform the Reception at 00 33 (0)4 90 65 60 18, or the guard between 7 pm and 8:30 am at 00 33 (0)4 90 65 99 50.
- Stay calm and read carefully the security and evacuation rules which are indicated on any Information board and Inside the shops.
- At the sound signal, go to the meeting point.
- In any case, do not take your car, it could block the access for the fire brigade.
- If you know how to manipulate a fire extinguisher or a fire-hose, please let this know to the team.

Instructions in case of rain and flood

- I inform myself and I remain attentive to the instructions of the authorities in the media and on social networks by following the official accounts.
- I do not take my car and postpone my travels.
- I care about my family, my neighbours and vulnerable



- I move away from the streams and I do not park on the sides or under bridges.
- I do not go out. I hide in a building and not under a tree to avoid the risk of lightning.
- I do not go down in the basement and I refuge on a upper floor.
- I don't take my car or leave on foot. I avoid an submersible bridge or a tunnel. Less than 30 centimeters is enough to flood away a car.
- I will not pick up my children at the Mini Club, they are safe with our staff.



The Domaine naturist de Bélézy is a «Centre Privé Gymnique de Plein Air», with 320 pitches. Upon arrival, each guest must be aware of these regulations, accept the provisions of these regulations, and undertakes to comply with them.

1. Admission

Access to the site is strictly reserved for naturists. Only the Management can authorize certain external persons to circulate on the Domain for service reasons.

2. Behavior

COMPLETE NUDITY IS COMPULSORY on the grounds of the Domain.

designed for this purpose. Nudity is forbidden on the public communal road (parking B1 and B2). Being comprehensive to this rule you respect those who do not appreciate nudity on a public area. Anyone not respecting this rule may be asked to leave the grounds with no recourse. Nudity is forbidden at the «Cargo/disco» and during dance evenings.

3. Alcool and narcotics

The use of alcohol and drugs is strictly prohibited on the domain. However, the consumption of alcohol is tolerated in private areas: pitches, accommodation, as long as it is not offensive and does not harm others, as well as in the restaurant when it is open. Drunkenness on the domain is not tolerated. Any offender will be expelled from the Domaine. If the offender is a minor, he or she will be sent back to his or her parents and the family will face expulsion.

4. Environment

It is forbidden to cut trees, branches and flowers, to uproot the plants and clumps. Any degradation of vegetation or equipment (fences, various installations) will be charged to its author, with prejudice to expulsion which may be decided in certain cases.

5. Car

Think of children and dust, ride slowly! Strictly respect the instructions concerning the forbidden directions, the speed limit at 5 km/h, the car parks and the non-circulation of cars inside the Domain. From June to September, cars must not park inside the Estate; vehicles are only authorized to enter it to bring or remove a tent or caravan during the two hours following arrival or preceding departure. We ask that you do not park your vehicles on free camping pitches. For the safety of children, respect for the environment, fauna and flora and the tranquility of all, all cars without exception must be parked in outdoor or reserved car parks.



6. Bicycle and step

The use of these vehicles is only authorized on the paths and on the leisure park, but in no case in the sanitary facilities, at the swimming pool, in the restaurant or in front of the Mas and must respect the speed limit of 5 km/h.

7. Radio & noises

From 11 pm. to 7 am., silence is required on the pitches. Some exemptions may be granted by the Management on the occasion of certain exceptional events: July 14 & 21, August 15. If you come home late at night, think of others: loud conversations and slamming of doors disturb those who sleep.

8. Photographs & Vidéos

It is strictly forbidden to photograph or film a group or a person without having received authorization. The Management reserves the right to keep the images/films in case of conflict.

9. Animals

For safety and hygiene reasons, dogs, cats and other pets are not permitted on the Domain.

10. Chairs and Benches

For hygiene reasons and to respect everyone's nudity, please bring a towel to sit on the chairs and benches. After use, we are grateful if you put them back in their place..

11 . Deckchairs

Deckchairs are available around the swimming pools and cannot be reserved in advance. If they are not occupied for 15 min, you can dispose of them. For hygiene reasons, protect them with a towel.

12. For the tranquility of everyone

The Domaine de Bélézy is a place of calm and rest; ball games, cycling, petanque must imperatively be organized in the leisure park and are prohibited elsewhere.

13 . Sanitary blocks

Our housekeepers clean the sanitary units daily. Please clean out water and sand after use, rinse the sink, showers etc. Throw your waste strictly in the bins for this use and

not in those of the sanitary units. Please use the equipment of the sanitary units only for which it is meant. Please also respect the proper use of furniture: dishwashing tubs, baby baths, etc.

14. Dustbins - Paper and GlassÒ

Bin rooms and sorting containers (glass, paper, etc.) are available on the Domain, in car parks B1 and B2. You can deposit your used batteries in a collector at the reception and for your kitchen waste, a composter is available next to the farm. Do not forget that recycling, ecology and naturism are concepts to be brought together!

The wooden bins placed on the Domain are reserved for small waste and must under no circumstances be used for household waste.

- Papers: the smaller they are, the more they are numerous: teach your children to throw chewing-gum and other packag.
- Cigarette butts: non-biodegradable and polluting, to be crushed in ashtrays.

15 . Piercings

We ask people with piercings in intimate places to remove them during their stay in Bélézy. The naturist rules of life exclude any ambiguity or any form of exhibitionism or provocation.

16. Thefts - Claims

The management of the domain declines any responsibility concerning thefts, accidents, sinisters, etc, which the campers could be victims of on the ground of Bélézy. Any stealing or offence will lead to immediate expulsion, without prejudice of legal proceedings which could be engaged.

Teens

- Nudity: Nudity is the basis of naturist life. **No exceptions will be accepted at the pool.** However, a towel or a pareo will be tolerated on the leisure park during the day.
- Attitude: During specific activities organized for young people and supervised by our staff we will be extremely attentive to :
 - Alcohol consumption: the "Cargo"does not sell alcoholic beverages and we do not accept the consumption of alcohol brought by young people (see § 3 of the rules).
 - Activities: The teens' activities are totally tolerated as long as the sleep of others is respected!

The Belezy team is glad to welcome the teenagers and to organize specific activities for them, proving that naturism is accepted as a modern practice.



"Naturism is a way of life in harmony with nature, that is expressed by a collective nudity, the purpose is to encourage the respect for itself, for the others and for the environment".

- 1. The keystone of naturism, integrated in its own definition, the way it was adopted at the international congress of the naturist federation of 1974, and made official since then, is a full time behaviour to which every person is committed.
- 2. Living in the Domain of Bélézy, means therefore, being committed to practice nudity to encourage others to cause others practice it (family, invited guests who are under your responsibility).
- 3. No exception is admitted other than special climate conditions, or temporary physical impossibility.
- **4.** It goes without saying that this constant practice of nudity is inseparable from all the benefits that can be expected:
- self-respect, respect for others for lack of any provocation. Naturism aimed at simplicity with modesty and not with exhibitionism.
- respect for the environment and places through good behavior, mutual help, attention to others and cleanliness.
- **5.** It belongs to the Domain to organize and to let respect this exercise, helped in this perspective by the naturist club of Bélézy Provence (CNBP) that represents all Béléziens. Any group or individual who doesn't respect this way of life or the domain's regulations will have to leave the area immediately.
